

Directions

From Montgomery, travel north on I-85. Take exit 15 to AL-110 towards Union Springs. Stay on AL-110 until it ends at US 82. Turn left onto US 82E and travel through Union Springs to Midway. Once in Midway, turn right onto AL-51, then turn left onto Pleasant Hill Road and travel 4.8 miles to the main entrance on your right. The brown "Nature Center" signs in Midway will also guide you to the tract.

From Eufaula, travel west on US 82 for 16.7 miles. Turn left onto Barbour Co. Rd. 49. Travel 4.4 miles and turn right on Mt. Pleasant Rd. at the brown "Nature Center" sign. Travel 2.7 miles to the Wehle Land Conservation Center entrance.
